This year in Brighton, we will be holding a four day pop-up event featuring on-site demonstrations enabling visitors to truly understand glass as a material and its upcycling potential to create designs ranging from tableware to architectural applications.

Our demonstrations will show that you can heat and manipulate glass with just low energy and basic equipment consisting of a mobile glass blowing facility and a flame work bench.

There will be opportunities throughout each day to interact with the demonstrators and organisers, discuss ideas and share information and completed upcycled pieces will be on display throughout the event.
